

RESOLUTION A.199(VI)

RELATIONS WITH THE NON-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS

The Assembly,

*Taking note* of Part XII of the Convention on the Inter-Governmental Maritime Consultative Organization and in particular Article 48,

*Recalling* that Rule 1 of the Rules Governing Relationship with Non-Governmental International Organizations requires that the Assembly approve consultative status granted by the Council to such organizations,

*Recalling further* that Rule 10 of the same Rules provides for periodic review of the list of non-governmental international organizations in consultative status with IMCO and a report to the Assembly on the continuation of such status,

*Having considered* the request of the Council at its twenty-second session to approve the grant of consultative status to the following, as bodies which are able to make a substantial contribution to the work of the Organization:

Baltic and International Maritime Conference  
International Association of Classification Societies  
International Law Association  
International Cargo Handling Co-ordination Association, and

*Having also considered* the Council's determination at its twenty-second session with regard to the continuation of the consultative status of certain organizations,

*Approves* the decision taken by the Council in conformity with Rule 1 of the above-mentioned Rules to grant consultative status to the above-mentioned bodies, and

*Endorses* the determination of the Council to continue the consultative status of the following:

RESOLUTION A.200(VI)

PRINTING FUND

The Assembly,

*Noting* that the Printing Fund established by the Secretary-General under Financial Regulation 6.7 has shown its value by making the revenue from sales of publications available for reprints and hence by facilitating control and review of the expenditures and receipts incurred in producing publications destined, wholly or in part, for sale,

*Recalling* that hitherto the purposes of the Printing Fund and the sources of its funds have been specified in Resolution A.100(IV),

*Now decides*, in order to improve the effectiveness of the Printing Fund, to authorize the Secretary-General, in addition:

- (a) to pay from the Printing Fund the costs incurred in the editing of publications and their sales;
- (b) to charge to the Printing Fund an appropriate proportion of the capital cost of new equipment to be used for the production of saleable items.
